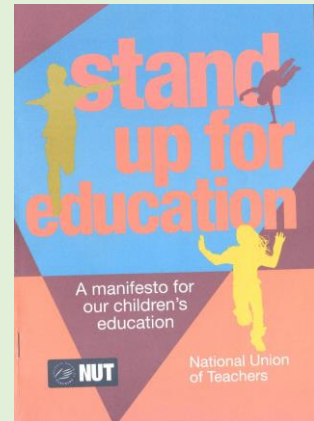

9. We need teaching to be an attractive profession



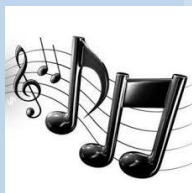

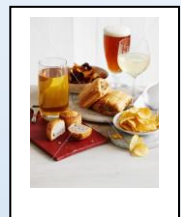
